



# *Mission 360*

## the Sixth Annual Mission 360 Bicycle Adventure

*June 26—July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010*

Mission 360 (M360) is a six day, 360 mile bicycle ride down the coast of California from the Watsonville area in northern California to Malibu in southern California. In 2010 the ride will take place from Saturday, June 26 through Thursday July 1, returning to northern California on Friday, July 2. This year's event will be the sixth M360 ride.

The sponsoring organization for M360 is Horizon Community Church in Galt, CA, and the ride, among other purposes, serves as a fundraiser for World Vision's ([www.worldvision.org](http://www.worldvision.org)) work in alleviating the HIV/AIDS crisis in the country of Lesotho in southern Africa. Everyone is welcome on M360, and anyone interested in riding should know that many of the M360 participants are Christians, and we offer Christian oriented activities (informal campfire evening service each night, testimonials, worship singing, etc.) over the course of the weeklong event. From 2005 through 2009 we have raised over \$143,000 for missions work in Africa and Nicaragua.



The riders are fully supported by an enthusiastic crew who drive SAG vehicles, cook all meals (and clean up), and provide transportation to our starting location and from our finishing point. We all camp along the way each night, and stay at the Hilton hotel at Universal City on the last night of the event. The cost of M360, shown below, covers all of the costs of the event, except of course for your own basic camping and cycling equipment.

*Riders and support crew will be accepted on a first come, first served basis dependent on payment of a non-refundable \$150 deposit, or \$300 full payment. An additional fee may be required for any special hotel arrangements. This year's event is capped at forty riders and ten support crew.*

- Transportation start and end point Galt, California (get here and leave the rest to us!)

- Greatest elevation Day Approximately 11,000 vertical feet
- Longest ride day Approximately 68 miles, mostly flat
- Shortest ride day Approximately 48 miles, mostly flat
- Camping equipment needed Tent, sleeping bag, air mattress if desired
- Provided service/accoutrements All meals, transportation, camping and hotel costs
